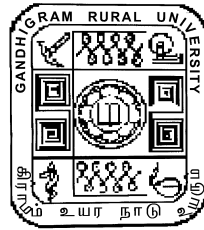

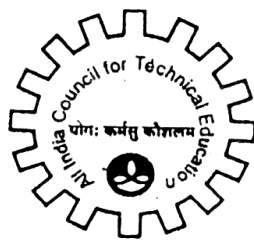

2 ii) Brief details regarding background of the Trust/Society, Governing body members, etc.

Born in the year of India's independence, Gandhigram a village purposively named after the father of the nation, was established by a team of Gandhiji's dedicated followers led by Dr. G. Ramachandran and Dr.T.S.Soundaram. Sprawling over a wide area in a scenic valley with the Sirumalai range on the east and the Kodai Hills on the west, Gandhigram presents an ideal location for radiating education and service to the scores of rural communities in its vicinity and beyond. Gandhigram is a vibrant bundle of educational, training, welfare and production institutions completely oriented towards rural development.

With a view to providing a rural and rural problem-centred education to the rural youth and to train them as social engineers for serving in rural areas, a Rural Institute of Higher Education was established in 1956 as part of a national experiment which included thirteen other centres. The experiment was based on Gandhiji's revolutionary concept of NAI TALIM system of education. The programme of rural higher education was considered to be a healthy deviation from the mainstream traditional higher education in India. While most of these centers of rural higher education got affiliated to conventional universities, Gandhigram Rural Institute struck steadfastly to its original vision, and, after 20 years of yeoman service in the field of rural higher education, it became a deemed university under Section 3 of the UGC Act of 1956 on 3rd August 1976.

The Institute was registered as a society on 29.07.76 under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act. (Registration number S.NO 20 of 1976).

Dr. G. Ramachandran and Dr. T.S. Soundaram Ramachandran were direct disciples of Mahatma Gandhiji. Both of them were freedom fighters.

Dr. G. Ramachandran was a student of Rabindaranath Tagore at Santhiniketan and had his post graduation from there. Immediately after independence along with his wife Dr.T.S. Soundaram Ramachandran, he started Gandhigram with the blessings of Mahatma Gandhi. He served as the Chairman, Khadi and Village Industries Commission, Mumbai, Rajya Sabha member, and Minister for Education of the Government of Kerala.

Dr. T.S. Soundaram Ramachandran, the daughter of the great industrialist T.V. Sundram Iyengar, was a doctor by profession. She along with her husband promoted Gandhigram. She was Minister of State for Education when Jawaharlal Nehru was the Prime Minister. She was also Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha). She devoted her life to promoting the socio-economic interests of children and women from marginalized communities.

The other promoters were Sri. S.V. Chittibabu, Dr. R. Srinivasan, Miss.Shanthi Manuel and Sri. S. Ramanujam. They were all eminent educationists and educational administrators.

The Gandhigram rural institute with an impeccable record in the field of rural higher education was accorded the status of deemed university in the year 1976 by the UGC. Fully funded by the UGC, the institute has grown leaps and bounds by introducing new academic programmes, by undertaking action-oriented research, and by reaching the community through its outreach activities.

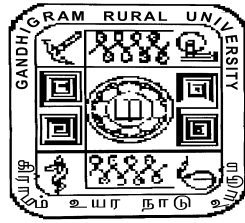
